Congratulations! I am pleased to inform you that the proposal from the Manchaug Pond Foundation for the *Manchaug Pond Water Quality Improvements and Agricultural Outreach* has been recommended to be funded. The recommended grant amount is \$225,190.

All awards are predicated on congressional allocation to the 319 grant program and your proposed scope and budget could be reduced or adjusted accordingly. Final approval of all proposals is contingent upon EPA's approval of the recommendations. It is also contingent upon the total amount of the Department's final 319 appropriation from EPA. In addition, final award of each 319 grant is contingent upon negotiation of an acceptable scope of services, budget, and project schedule between the Department and the Grantee prior to April 1, 2021.

The final 319 appropriation will be received from EPA during the spring of 2021. The 319 program staff will work with you to negotiate the final scope, budget, and timeline so that the contract processing can begin promptly once the grant funds are in place. The expected start date for FFY2021 projects is in the late spring of 2021.
